Installation Report

Mounting a TV to a stone wall is not easy. The wall is concrete, the stone is uneven, and the bracket is high. Especially when using a cantilever style mount. This type allows you to pull the TV out, then swing and tilt. The mounting surface must be sturdy and perfectly plumb. Otherwise the TV will "fall" away from the wall, and/or to either side.

This is what the Sara and Adam needed to complete their living room AV system. We fastened a plywood rectangle on top of the stone, using concrete anchors with extra long screws to reach the mortar deep between the stones. Wood shims were placed behind the board to keep the wood surface plumb and flat. To fasten the mounting hardware to the plywood, special nuts were added behind the wood for machine screws.
